RELATING TO CARRIE TINGLEY CRIPPLED CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL; PROVIDING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE CARRIE TINGLEY CRIPPLED CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL PROGRAM BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEW MEXICO; AMENDING, REPEALING AND ENACTING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 23-2-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1937, Chapter 13, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

CREATED.--In order to provide care and treatment for the crippled children of New Mexico in need of long-term inpatient or outpatient the care, there is hereby created the Carrie Tingley crippled children's hospital program to be administered by the board of regents of the university of New Mexico. For the purposes of this section, "crippled children" means children whose primary diagnosis is a chronic impairment which may require long-term inpatient or outpatient medical or surgital care or treatment."

Section 2. Section 23-2-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1937, Chapter 13, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:

"23-2-2. ADVISORY COMMITTEE..--The board of regents of the university of New Mexico shall appoint and consult with an advisory group consisting of at least three parents of children with a chronic impairment and two health professionals."
