MORRIS, and said parties having agreed that the sum of Two Hundred Ten Thousand and no/100 (\$210,000.00) Dollars is the present fair market value of the property described in the complaint herein owned by defendant E. METZ BEAHN and that petitioner shall pay defendant E. METZ BEAHM said amount for the condemnation of said property; and the Court being fully advised in the premises; now, therefore, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DEGREED that the petitioner be and it is hereby granted fee simple title in and to the real estate described as follows:
